Dr. Ian Roderick, affiliated member of the Institute, advances research within two priority research themes of the MS2Discovery Institute: Human Interface Technology and Design (Tecton 10).

Dr. Roderick joined the Institute in 2014. He came to Wilfrid Laurier University in 2003 where he is now an Associate Professor and the undergraduate advisor for the Department of Communication Studies.
